



Help For Haiti

Logistics provider TMT, Inc. will be aiding the Haitian relief services in a joint project with the Detroit Pistons, Walgreens, and Detroit-based relief organizations and news media.

TMT will transport relief packages bound for Haiti. “Where the need is urgent and where we have the ability to help, we feel compelled to act,” said Tony Marks, CEO of TMT, Inc. “The devastation there is immeasurable – it’s hard to imagine how and when the Haitian people will recover. But, if each of us does what is within our power to do, we can help them get there.”

TMT tractor-trailers will carry supplies from Detroit to North Carolina and Florida, where they will be readied for delivery to Haiti. The items TMT will transport include donations of medical supplies and hygiene products being collected at Detroit-area Walgreens stores and team jerseys and shoes donated by the Detroit Pistons. The effort will be administered by Forgotten Harvest, a Michigan-based food bank dedicated to collecting food for the needy.
